Overview of Seosan Citizens Center

The Seosan Citizens Center, located at Beonhwa 1-ro, Seosan City, offers various meeting rooms and sharing services, which are posted on the “Popular Resources” menu of the GongyuNuri website. Since the Center opened on May 15, 2020, 7,620 citizens have used the facilities, a monthly average of 400 citizens.

On the first floor, there is a Youth Vitality Space Lab and an Urban Regeneration Support Center. The Community Hall has computers for citizens to use. Each club room and meeting room can accommodate up to 15 people.

On the second floor, there is the Public Interest Activity Support Center, where citizens can cultivate their ability and engage in public interest activities, and the Community Building Support Center helps foster a sustainable community culture.

Exploring the potential of public resources for sharing

The Seosan Citizens Center also contains a book café, an office, and a kitchen as shared resources.

The book café has 1,500 books donated through 'Book Café Vitalization Campaign' and was noted by 'Book U Love with Carrier', a popular reading and entertainment TV program. The 'Shared Office' is a service to provide individuals or groups office space for a certain period to do public interest activities. All citizens of Seosan City can apply to use the space. There is also a shared kitchen.

Going forward, the Seosan Citizens Center plans to host 'One Day Classes' (one-day experiential activity) and 'Sharing Volunteer Activities' where members can engage in volunteer service or ecological activities and introduce their activities and ideas. These activities will be posted on the GongyuNuri website to attract more citizens.

Seosan City is opening a sustainable way of sharing resources

Amid the growing sharing economy, Seosan City is exploring and promoting the use of community resources and spaces which citizens are not aware of. The city government posts tourist attractions, cultural facilities, and WiFi services on the GongyuNuri website so citizens can access them anytime. In addition, the city plans to expand the range of resources by opening the resources of public institutions, public corporations, and municipal facilities.
